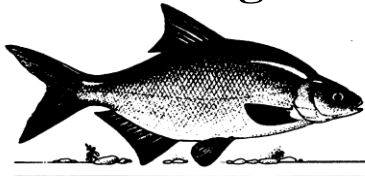

The code of conduct for parents/carers is an important code to allow parents and carers to support their children within the sport and help in their development.

- Ⓜ Encourage your child to learn the rules and participate within them.
- Ⓜ Discourage unfair participation and arguing with officials.
- Ⓜ Help your child to recognise good performance, not just results.
- Ⓜ Never force your child to take part in sport.
- Ⓜ Set a good example by recognising fair play and applauding good performances of all.
- Ⓜ Never punish or belittle a child for losing or making mistakes.
- Ⓜ Publicly accept officials' judgments.
- Ⓜ Support your child's involvement and help them to enjoy their sport.
- Ⓜ Use correct and proper language at all times.
- Ⓜ Encourage and guide participants to accept responsibility for their own performance and behaviour.
- Ⓜ Actively encourage all children taking part to fish for themselves.
